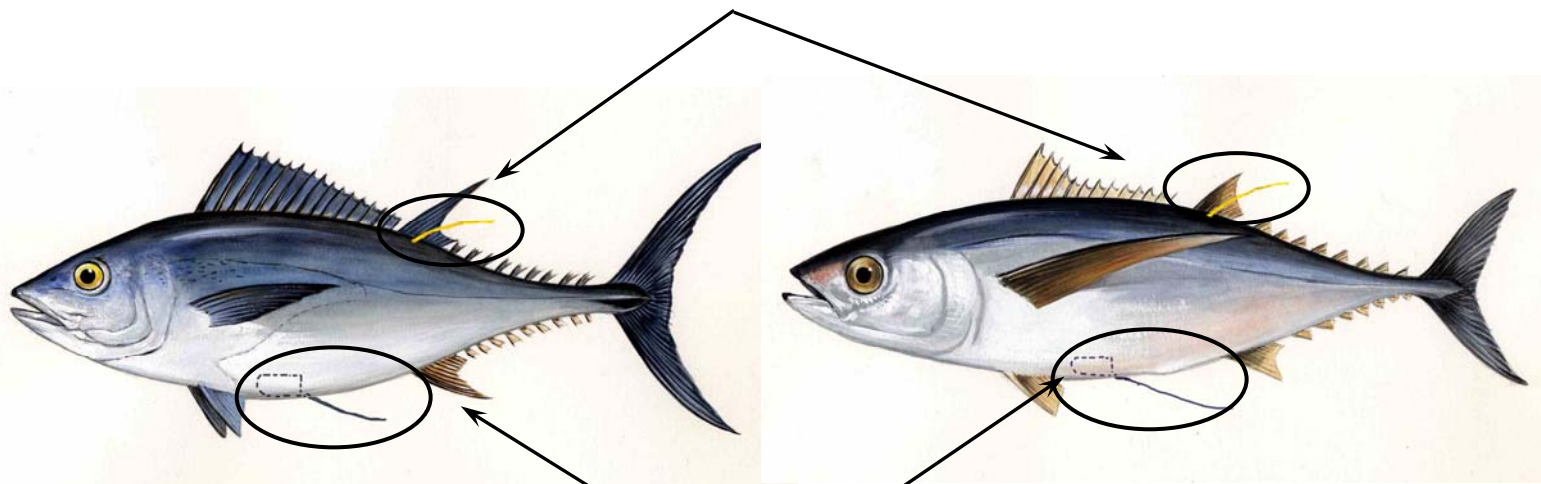

PROCEDURES FOR GETTING YOUR REWARD:

1. At sea:

KEEP the whole fish with the archival tag. **Do not remove the archival tag by pulling on the light sensor!**

NOTE: (1) **Number of the tags**. (2) **Location** and **date** of recapture

2. In the port:

NOTIFY the recapture with information above and (3) **name of the ship**, (4) **fishing gear**, (5) your **name and address** in one of the next ways

How do you determine that a tuna has an archival tag? Archival tags are implanted in the body cavity of the tuna and only the light sensor protrudes out of the body. However, they also carry external conventional streamer tags in the second dorsal fin.
